

The “Morning After”

June 16, 2009

Monday, June 15, 2009, President David Howard called the regular meeting of the River Ridge Community Unit School District #210 Board of Education to order at 7:00 pm. Board Members David Howard, Barb Schaible, Allen Crist, Don Altfillisch, Raymie Diestelmeier, Merri Sevey and Matt Wild answered roll call. Also present: Superintendent Brad Albrecht, Principal Pete Scarano, Principal Mike Foltz, representatives from the RREA and community.

Approved the regular and executive session board meeting minutes of May 18, 2009 and destruction of audio executive session minutes from November 19, 2007.

Reviewed the Treasurer’s Report, Investment Report and Activity Reports. Approved bills and payroll in the amount of \$642,402.20.

Virtue/Gillespie/Steele scholarship recipient, Mattie Radke, thanked the Board for awarding her this honor.

AVC representative, Raymie Diestelmeier, reported on the June 1, 2009 Jo Daviess Carroll Area Vocational Center minutes. It was recommended that the construction trades class work on rehab and city projects. Andrew Kruser was offered the construction trades position.

Superintendent Albrecht was instructed to look into replacing the high mileage carry-alls.

The Board discussed the 2009-2010 senior class trip. The Washington, D. C. trip has been extended from two days to three days on a trial basis for one year.

Permission granted to the Durrant Group, Inc., school district architect, to obtain bids for lighting in the commons and gyms.

Instructed the high school principal and athletic director to consider new volleyball uniforms.

Adopted the Prevailing Wage Resolution.

Supt. Albrecht reported on: budget, levy decrease to 2.89, .01 Sales Tax, bus barn concrete completed, middle school area carpeting, consideration of fuel bid and superintendents meeting with Jo Carroll Energy to discuss rate increase.

Approved the extra-duty assignments for the 2009-2010 school year as presented.

New assignments: Pom Squad – Lara Walters and Speech – Judy Tippet

Instructed administrators to search for an additional kindergarten teacher.
