World Class Scholarship FAQ

- **What is the World Class Scholarship Program**
 - A scholarship program begun in 2002 by Mediacom to aid graduating high school seniors with their expenses during their first year of college.
- **How much is the scholarship?**
 - \$1,000.00
- **Who is eligible?**
 - High School Seniors who are graduating in 2008 and live in the areas serviced by Mediacom are eligible.
- **How can I be sure if I live in an eligible area?**
 - There are three ways to find out if you are living in an eligible area
 - There is a list of towns attached to the application. It shows all the towns where Mediacom is currently available. If you have trouble reading the list, a copy is available online at www.mediacomworldclass.com that can be zoomed in on.
 - Copies of the application are being mailed out to all high schools within the eligible area. If your school counselor receives a copy of the application, then you most likely are eligible.
 - If your town is serviced by Mediacom, you will be eligible. Call your local Mediacom office to determine if you live in a serviceable area.
- **What is needed to apply?**
 - Make sure all following items are in your packet before you send it out. Incomplete packets will be automatically rejected.
 - A completed copy of the application. Leave nothing blank. If a section does not apply to you, please fill in with "N/A"
 - A copy of your high school transcript – **Important:** this should not be sent separately. It must be in your packet when mailed.
 - Two references from your school. **These MUST be sent in your packet. They will not be accepted if sent separately.**
 - An essay on "Leadership".
