

## RALPH & KATHERINE NORRIS SCHOLARSHIP

The Ralph and Katherine Norris Scholarship Fund has been established to provide financial assistance to Jo Daviess County residents studying agriculture or agricultural related fields. The Jo Daviess County Extension & 4-H Foundation is responsible for the selection of the scholarship recipients.

Scholarships of approximately \$1500.00 will be awarded as funds permit

### Eligibility:

- Jo Daviess County, Illinois resident
- Must be enrolled in agriculture or agricultural related studies
- Must be enrolled in a two or four year program
- Must be accepted at chosen school, college or university
- Must be full time student, 12 hours minimum per semester; auditing of classes cannot be included in the minimum
- Must have a GPA of "C" average or above

The Jo Daviess County Extension & 4-H Foundation will make selection based on the materials that the applicant provides. The application must be typewritten or computer generated.

The Jo Daviess County Extension & 4-H Foundation reserves the right to make judgment on cases not covered by the above guidelines.

A new application must be submitted each year. Each year a current transcript including GPA must be submitted with the application. The GPA must be a "C" average or above. Scholarship recipients cannot receive the scholarship for more than 4 years. Clear and concise applications are greatly appreciated.

This scholarship will be paid directly to the winners in two installments: one at the beginning of the first semester or quarter upon proof of enrollment, the second upon the start of the second semester. A written verification letter of enrollment from the school and a final 1<sup>st</sup> semester grade report of "C" or above is required in order for the recipient to obtain the second installment. This information must be sent to the **Extension Office by January 15 of each year**. If not, the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate. If applicant is chosen for a 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or 4<sup>th</sup> year scholarship, a final second semester or summer grade report of "C" or above must be sent to the **Extension Office by September 1**. This is needed to show proof that applicant was enrolled and completed the previous semester. If not, the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate.

If for some reason the recipient is unable to enroll or withdraws from school, the awarded scholarship will be returned in full, for that semester, to the Norris Scholarship Fund.

A first and second alternate may be selected.

A letter indicating whether or not they are the recipients of a scholarship will be sent to each applicant.
