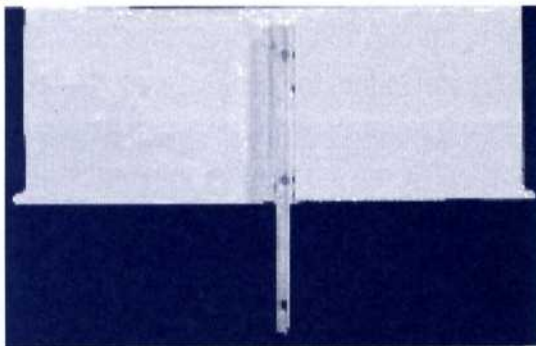
TIPS FOR COMPLETING YOUR APPLICATION

Start the application process early. Visit www.elks.org/enf/findalodge.cfm to find the Elks Lodge nearest to where you live. Contact the Lodge for application drop-off times.

Read the instructions. We include them for your benefit; knowing exactly what you need to do will make the application process go faster and easier. For answers to Frequently Asked Questions, visit www.elks.org/enf/scholars/mvsfaq.cfm

Don't forget to make a copy. All applications become the property of the B.P.O. Elks of the U.S.A. and the Elks National Foundation and will **not** be returned to you.

Make life easier for the judges. When you're finished, do not staple or use paperclips on any part of your application. Do not use plastic sleeves to protect the pages. Simply place it, as instructed, in a folder.



The type of folder you should use for your application is pictured above.

Don't hesitate to ask questions. If you are unable to get a hold of someone at the Lodge, visit www.elks.org/enf/scholars/statechairmen.cfm to find your state scholarship representative's contact information.

Use this handy checklist to ensure that you are submitting all required items. (Please arrange items in this order.)

- Completed Application. Original, typed or neatly printed, no pencil, three-hole punched and placed in a folder.
- Essay (signed and dated).
- Official Transcript of Grades. Include Seventh semester classes. Seventh semester grades are not required.
- SAT and/or ACT scores taken before November 15, 2010.
- Counselor Report in a sealed envelope.
- Copies of Exhibits. Optional. Double-sided acceptable.
- Take application to your local Lodge on or before **December 1, 2010.**
